Evaluation Criteria for Employers for the importation of foreign labour

- A. Employers will be evaluated by the MCIA based on the following criteria:
- 1. Recruitment Capacity:
 - Demonstrated ability to vet and verify the skills and suitability of labourers by sector (Sugar, Food-Crop, Livestock).
- 2. Logistics Capacity:
 - Capability to organize and manage transport of workers from India to Mauritius within approved timelines.
- 3. Accommodation and Welfare:
 - Provision of adequate housing and living conditions for workers, if any.
- 4. Training and Integration:
 - Ability to provide or facilitate skills training and orientation programmes to help workers adapt to local agricultural practices and conditions.
- 5. Monitoring and Compliance:
 - Systems to be put in place to monitor and manage worker performance, ensuring compliance with contractual terms and labour regulations.
- 6. Local Deployment Logistics:
 - Capacity to transport and deploy workers daily to assigned fields /farms.
- 7. Preferred Area of Operation:
 - Declaration of specific regions or districts in which the Employer intends to operate.
